Rocks, Minerals & Landforms Vocabulary

- Crystal:** The solid, chemical structure of a mineral.
- Habit:** The repeating shape of a crystal.
- Mineral:** A natural, non-living solid material.
- Luster:** A mineral's ability to reflect light.
- Streak:** The colored mark that a mineral makes when it is rubbed against a (white tile).
- Moh's Scale:** A comparison of minerals based on their hardness.
- Igneous:** A natural, non-living material made up of one or more minerals.
- Sedimentary:** Describes rock that forms when completely melted rock cools and hardens.
- Metamorphic:** Describes rock that is changed by pressure and partial melting.
- Sedimentary:** Describes rock that forms when eroded sediments are pressed together.
