
How to Use:

Sight Lights can be used in a variety of ways! They come in small and large-sized cards. Here are a few of my favorite ways to use Sight Lights:

1. Display in a pocket chart, on a word wall, or on a “Lighting Up Bright Readers” bulletin board, as each sight word is introduced.
2. Photocopy multiple sets on cardstock, or copy and glue them onto construction paper so that the cards are not see through. Then, laminate the cards for students to play Memory, “Go Sight Light” (like Go Fish) and Sight Light Tic-Tac-Toe.
3. Laminate and hole punch the bottom corner. Keep multiple sets on rings for guided reading group practice, independent practice, or to send home with students.
4. Place magnetic tape on the back of each laminated Sight Light card and use for an interactive whiteboard writing center.
5. Use the large Sight Lights and play music to let students “twist and shout” sight words as you scroll through each slide.
