About Silent Response Cards:

WHO: Silent Response Cards are an interactive way for **ALL STUDENTS** to participate in learning!

WHAT: A set of 28 cards to allow responses for any subject!

WHERE: Use whole-class, in small group, or in a student-led group. Silent Response Cards are also a fantastic tool to have at home to practice various skills in a FUN way!

WHEN: Any time of day! Use Silent Response Cards for a review, a warm-up, a transition activity, or even for a fun “get to know you” activity.

WHY: **Because waiting to be called on gets frustrating!** **ALL STUDENTS** should have the opportunity to actively participate in the learning process!

How to Use Silent Response Cards:

1. Give each student a set of assembled Silent Response Cards (See Directions)
2. Ask the class a question (great for oral comprehension), or post a question on the screen or whiteboard.
3. Students find and hold up the appropriate Response Card(s) to answer the question...the teacher can quickly check for understanding by seeing correct colors/answers held up.

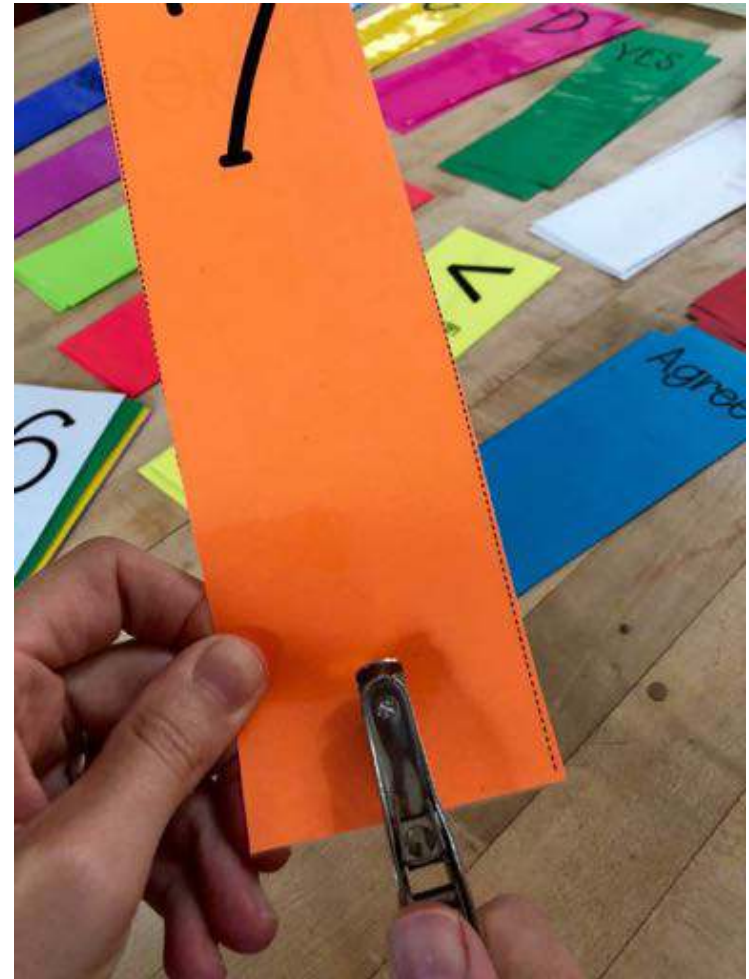
Ex: Question asked by teacher during a mental math warm-up.

“What is $300 \div 17$?”

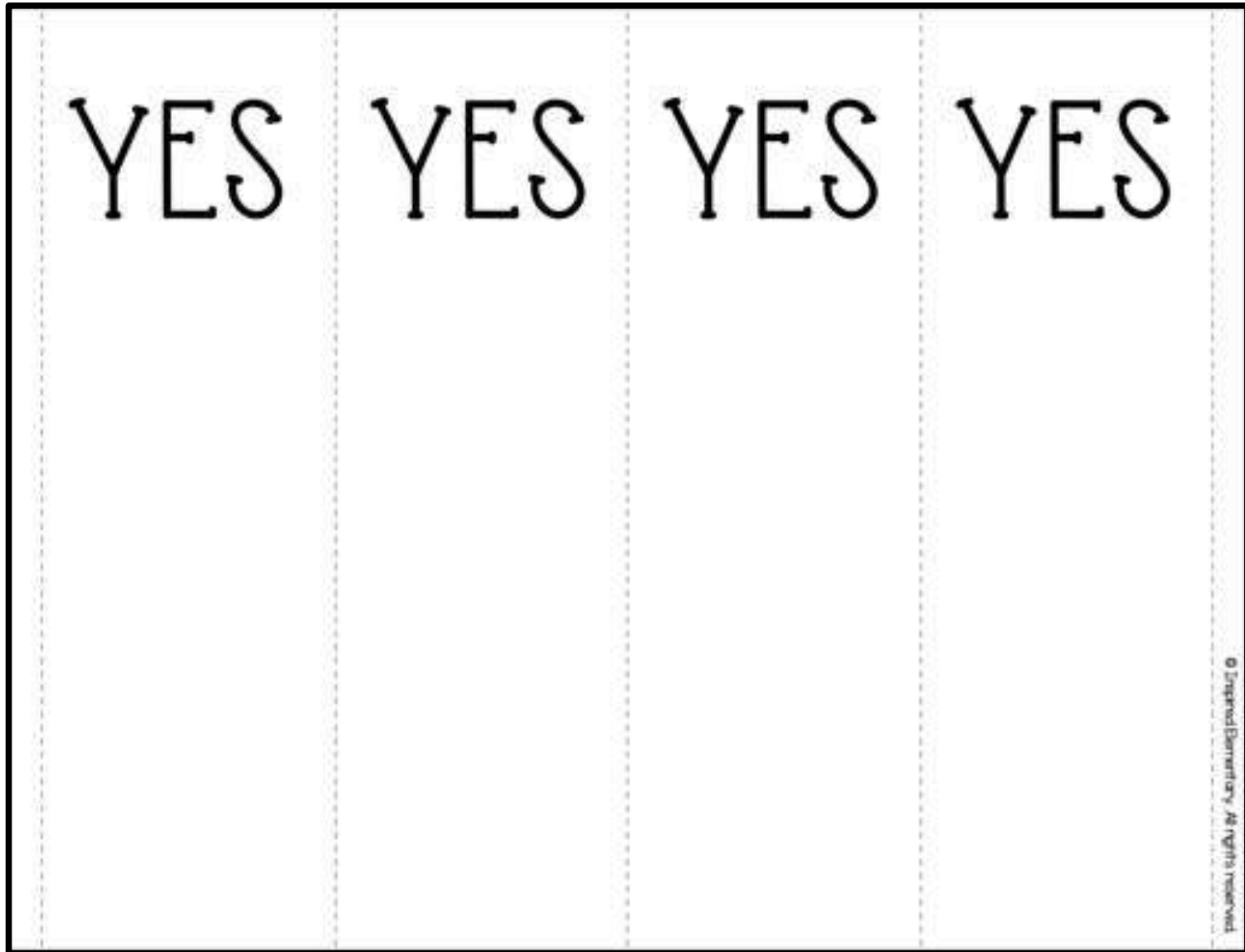
Students find the

correct answer: **317**



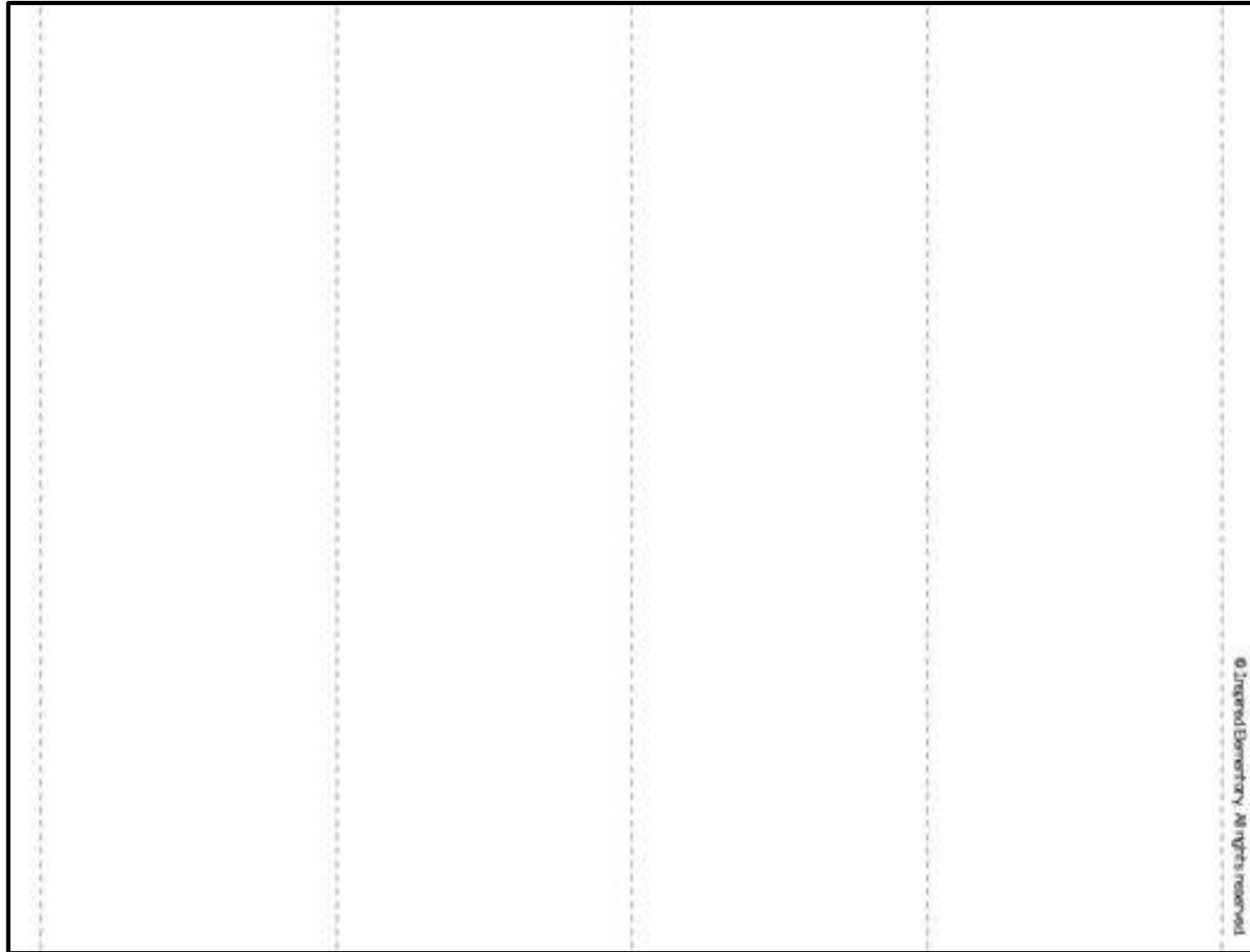
Step-By-Step Photo Directions for Easy Assembly
